



Earthquake - Emergency Kit

It is required for each child to have a personal earthquake - emergency kit at the center at all times. In the event of an earthquake or other emergency, your child may have to spend longer periods of time at the center than expected. This kit is prepared by parents and should include: Ready-to-feed formula in single serving cans or bottle or four clean bottles powder formula and bottles of water for three days • Three days supply of baby food in pouches. • Diapers, wipes and diaper rash cream • Extra clothes (warm clothes as well as cooler) and shoes • A blanket, pacifier and teething ring, a duplicate of child's favorite toy • Small bag to hold all items • Any prescription medication for your child.
